

**VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND FALLS
INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW
INCREASE IN FINES FOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC CODE VIOLATIONS**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Highland Falls, County of Orange, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 108-48, titled "Penalties for offenses," of Chapter 108, titled "Vehicles and Traffic," of the Code of the Village of Highland Falls is amended as follows:

- I. Subsection A is amended to read as follows:
 - A. Unless a different penalty is expressly required by the state Vehicle and Traffic Law, any person violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be punished, upon conviction, by a maximum fine of \$750 or by a term of imprisonment of not more than 15 days, or both, for each violation.

- II. The initial paragraph of subsection B is amended to read as follows:
 - B. Any person violating any of the following parking provisions shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine in an amount not less than the amount set forth below:

- III. Subsection B is further amended by increasing the fine for violation of the "Limited-time parking (meter parking)" regulation to \$25.

Section 2. This local law should take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
